Land Conservation, General/Other: TLC Farm continued to conserve its remarkable program site by demonstrating deeply valuable public human uses that also improve native habitat function, biodiversity, and ecological health. This included volunteer activities with youth and adult participants to selectively discourage highly active pioneer species (like English Ivy, Himalayan Blackberry, and the like), especially in maturing areas bordering Tryon Creek State Park. Community Capacity Building programs: TLC Farm acted as a catalyst for building relationships with many other organizations in the context of a holistic relationship with the earth. This is done in a wide variety of ways: by making the farm available for events to many different kinds of organizations, who then build relationships with each other; by specifically creating our own events that bring diverse communities and organizations together; and by developing ongoing partnerships of many kinds. In 2008, TLC Farm built global-scale relationships between sustainability learning centers as part of the Berkana Exchange annual meeting in Kufunda Village, Zimbabwe. Over a dozen deeply rooted learning centers from all continents exchanged experiences, skills, and wisdom. We also continued to host Mother Earth Kindergarten, a bio-immersion program which doubled the number of children spending most of their time outside learning through direct experience with the environment. Environmental & Sustainable Design, General/Other: TLC Farm continued to grow its research and demonstration projects exploring and illustrating integration of human and non-human habitat. TLC Farm volunteers transformed approximately a quarter acre from invasive blackberries into food forests and organic gardens. TLC Farm improved its infrastructure to support our programs by starting construction on a beautiful 1400 sq. ft. round-wood roof for the outdoor kitchen. The structure demonstrates a variety of techniques for efficiently using a widely available renewable resource in Oregon: small-diameter poles. We also initiated construction of an office loft in the barn, demonstrating a variety of natural and green building techniques, such as light clay/straw insulation, earthen plaster, and recycled materials. Sustainable animal husbandry was also showcased at TLC Farm through a Nubian dairy goat herd, which allowed city residents a rare opportunity to see and learn about traditional farm animals. Our two does had three baby goats in 2008, who dazzled farm visitors with their adorable antics. The goats also helped with invasive species removal, by browsing down fields of blackberries. Finally, the ReCode project gathered steam in its regional campaign to identify and remove legal and other barriers to sustainable building and land use. A city grant funded a part-time coordinator, who helped establish regular monthly educational meetings and five active working groups. Environmental Education Programs, General/Other: Various educational programs were carried out by TLC Farm in 2008. In addition, some groups were given forest ecology and watershed health lessons in the adjacent Tryon Creek State Park. Eight interns immersed themselves in TLC Farm during 2008, staying for 1 to 10 weeks. Interns participated in a wide variety of projects, from curriculum development and teaching, to extensive gardening and animal husbandry, to fundraising development, to building projects. TLC Farm hosted 18 community workshops on a wide variety of sustainability-related topics, including several weekend-long workshops. Workshops covered topics such as: Food Forests, Animal Husbandry, Graywater Systems, Earthen Plaster, Cheese Making and more. (est. 1615 student learning hours; 8 interns; 18 workshops)
